Governor DeWine has announced that effective on July 20, 2020, so long as all safety standards are met, skilled nursing facilities will be permitted to begin allowing outdoor visitation with residents.


In order to safeguard the health and wellbeing of our residents and staff, which remains our highest priority, we have established the attached visitation guidelines. Adherence with these guidelines is critical to the success of our visitation program. Visitation will be allowed by appointment only and must be scheduled in advance. To schedule an appointment, please contact Amanda Hrabak at 330-468-1800 ext. 659. Once your visit is scheduled, we will discuss our visitation guidelines, including any updates to those guidelines, as well as the details of your visit.

Please note that newly admitted residents and residents returning from the hospital are carefully monitored in our admissions unit and subject to additional precautions in order to limit potential transmission within our facility. These residents will not be able to participate in visitation until a period of at least 14 days has passed since their latest admission and they have satisfied certain medical and testing criteria.

We at Northfield Village Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation understand that spending time with your loved one is important and look forward to welcoming you back to our facility. We appreciate your support and understanding as we navigate these challenging times.
